


# The 2nd British Rowing European Tour Lakes, Canals and the River Alster 11<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> May 2017

#### Accommodation

In order to enable rowers and their partners, where appropriate, to experience the many different facets of Hamburg, flights and accommodation are **not** included within the package. Rowers are therefore free to choose the grade of accommodation and the location to most appropriate the rowers/partners requirements – close to the city centre, close to the lake etc.

To find accommodation one suggestion is to go to maps.google.com. On the search bar type Hamburg, go. On the search bar type hotels, go. Alternatively sites like Booking.com are very good and competitive or Hamburg-travel.com. There is also the official tourist site http://english.hamburg.de/visitors/.

Hotel accommodation in Hamburg goes very quickly. Please book accommodation very early to avoid disappointment. Many shops close on Sundays and Restaurants close early on Sundays.

There is a good bus service that travels around the lake and taxis are numerous and reasonably priced. The city centre is a short train journey away from the airport.

#### **Boating**

You will be boating from one of three or four rowing clubs, depending on party numbers. The clubs that have kindly offered boats are RG Hansa, Schulbehorde Langer Zug, RC Dresdenia and ARV Hanseat. The clubs are all based on the AuBenalster, a large lake. Each club will provide a guide during the rows and all boats will follow the same route.

#### Hotel location

The centre (Central Station area) is obviously the area for shopping, historical building, buses and most tourist activities, plus obviously coffee shops. The west side of the city leads eventually to the Reeperbahn, the red light area. The rowing clubs are to the north of the main lake. To the south of the River Elbe there is the port area which is best visited using the hop on-hop off bus. The warehousing is the home of many shops, cafes and museums.

#### **Boats**

All boat seats will be hired via RG Hansa. There are up to fifty seats available. All boats are sculls and hold up to 8 scullers plus cox. They are generally of a wooden construction and are in superb condition.
