Instructions to trailer drivers

Thursday 29th August 19

14:00 – 17:00 Deliver boats to appropriate venue as details below

Derwent Water

Isle of Ely trailer (towed by Broxbourne) with 6 boats - 4 Charles Stanley and 2 Broxbourne. NB A 7th boat and a safety boat are being supplied by Lakeland RC which are already on site.

Bassenthwaite

Weyfarers trailer towed by Weyfarers with 6 boats - 4 Weyfarers and 2 Leicester One further Upton boat on the Upton trailer will be dropped off on its way to Ullswater. The Weyfarers launch for safety cover.

<u>Ullswater</u>

Goring Gap trailer (towed by Falcon) with 4 Charles Stanley boats.

Upton trailer with 3 boats (towed by Upton) with 3 boats – 1 Upton and 2 Lancaster John O'Gaunt Tyne United trailer with 3 TURC boats (arriving in the evening)

Safety boat towed by Glenn Wouters

General instructions

The boats are to be left on the trailers on arrival. They will be off-loaded and rigged on Friday morning when the crews arrive.


The trailers will be left on site with these exceptions:

- 1. Derwent Water where the trailer will be left at Keswick Rugby Club (see map) until it is needed on Sunday.
- 2. The Upton trailer will take the Upton boat initially at Ullswater to Bassenthwaite Lake on Saturday afternoon after the row has finished. The trailer will be left at Bassenthwaite Lake until after the row on Sunday when it will return to Ullswater with the 2 Upton boats and collect the 2 Lancaster John O'Gaunt boats

Directions

From Junction 40 on the M6 travel west on the A66 for some 27 km. At an island turn left onto A 5271 to Keswick. After 750m turn left and after a further 750m turn right at a mini-island. Pass Booths on your right to find a right turn onto Crow Park Road. Beyond the turning into the Booths carpark take a right fork following Crow Park Road and passing the rugby club on the right. Continue onto the unsurfaced road—minding the pot holes and through woodland beyond which is an unfenced open section of road 250m long. Enter the woodland following the road round to the left. Lakeland RC have a compound in the woodland.

The trailer will be parked here over night in one of the gaps in the trees.

Directions

From Junction 40 on the M6 travel west on the A66 for some 40 km. After a section of narrow and windy dual carriageway take a right turn onto the B5291. After 100m fork right remaining on the B5291. After a further 200m you will see the entrance to the sailing club on the right. There is a sliding security gate. You will either be given a code to open the gate or someone will be there to open it for you.

After passing through the gate go straight ahead for 100m on a narrow surfaced road until it turns sharp left. The trailers can be left on the grass straight ahead but check how soft the ground is before proceeding off the hard road.

Directions

From Junction 40 on the M6 travel west on the A66 for 1.5km to an island where you turn left onto the A592. Continue on this road for 6km until a junction with the B5320 is reached. Turn left and after 750m cross the river into the village of Pooley Bridge. Continue for 250m through the village and take a right fork and then a right turn at a cross roads after a further 225m. Follow this narrow road for 2.5km to find the entrance to Ullswater Yacht Club on the right.

The gate should be open, if not ring the number above for help. Go straight ahead on a surfaced road for 170m to the edge of the lake. Our trailer park and boat storage area is on a grass strip on the right hand side adjacent to the water. Check how soft the ground is before proceeding off the hard road
