These days Dorney is most famous for [Dorney Lake](#), owned by Eton College and used for numerous regattas including the 2012 Olympic rowing and canoeing competitions. [Video](#)



Nearby is [Dorney Court](#), a Grade I listed Tudor manor house, dating from around 1440.



The tiny village of Dorney is now dissected by the [Jubilee River](#), built in the late 1990s and early 2000 as a flood relief channel. Because of the lake and the river, 13% of the area of Dorney village is water.

On the other side of the Thames is Oakley Green, home of [Bray Studios](#) where many Hammer Horror Films were made, including Dracula and Frankenstein.
