Runnymede is famous as the site of the signing of the Magna Carta in 1215. On either side of the A308, which runs along the river, are a memorial and lodge, designed by Lutyens:

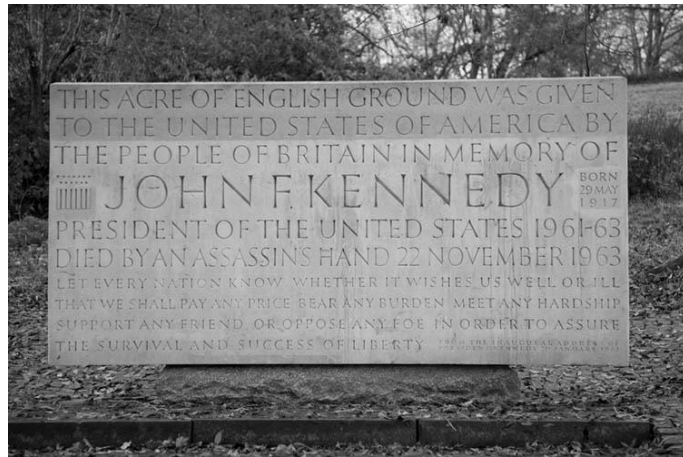


A new memorial was built in 2015, the 800th anniversary of the signing
