Windsor

Just before you reach Windsor, you pass **Eton Excelsior Rowing Club**, adjacent to Windsor Race Course.

Windsor Castle is the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world. Today The Queen spends most of her private weekends at the Castle, which is also used regularly for ceremonial and State occasions. Within the grounds is **St George's Chapel** the setting for the Royal wedding of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle, Duke and Duchess of Sussex. Take a <u>video tour</u>



As you row downstream, you pass through Windsor Great Park, with further views of the castle:



The bridges at either end of this stretch of river are the Victoria Bridge and Albert Bridge. The Thames Path crosses the river to the north side and back again over these bridges, as the Home Park is closed to visitors.
