

British Rowing Tour 2025

Instructions for Trailer Drivers

Thursday 28th August

14:00 – 16:00 Deliver boats to the Forest Hills Hotel, Overton Hill, Frodsham, Cheshire, WA6 6HH.

Note that there are two ways to get to the hotel from the centre of Frodsham. From the main road (B5152) go up Manley Road and continue until you reach Simons Lane. Continue onto Bellemonte Lane and turn left into the hotel car park. DO NOT go along Penkmans Lane, especially with a trailer, as it is narrow and bendy with lots of parked cars!

Park up and relax!

Friday 29th August

Tow trailers to Winsford Marina car park, CW7 3DA. This is off the A54 which is a dual carriageway, and coming from the hotel you will be on the wrong side! Go past the marina and there is a gap in the central reservation where you can cross over and take the driveway into the car park

Once the trailers have been unloaded, take them to Runcorn Rowing Club, Cholmondeley Road, Clifton WA7 4XT. All being well, their secure compound at the entrance to the road should be open for us to park the trailers. Return to Northwich RC for lunch.

Sunday 31st August

Collect trailers from Runcorn RC and take to Sandy Lane Sailing Club, Dee Banks, Chester, CH3 5UL. Go past the car park and the Aqua Park. We have permission to park on the grassy area next to the Sailing Club and have the code to open the gate.

Trailers unloaded, boats rigged, outing on the Dee.

After lunch, load trailers and return to Runcorn RC.

End of tour.

The Goring Gap and Isle of Ely trailers are going to Windermere for their event but we do not yet know when and where they are being collected. The Weyfarers trailer will return to Weybridge on Monday morning.
