

British Rowing Tour 2026

Instructions for Trailer Drivers

Thursday 4th July

14:00 – 16:00 Deliver boats – see below

Maidstone trailer (4 boats)

Mark Diessner delivers to Beccles Rowing Club. 6 volunteers needed to unload the trailer, if possible rig boats. Mark then takes empty trailer to Lowestoft RC. 2 boats also coming from Lowestoft RC to Beccles RC, rowed up by volunteers.

Isle of Ely trailer (4 boats)

Malcolm delivers to Norwich RC. 2 boats also loaned from Norwich RC. Trailer unloaded and boats rigged on Friday morning.

Goring Gap trailer (4 GG boats plus 2 Weyfarers boats)

John delivers to Norfolk Broads Yacht Club (Wroxham). Trailer unloaded and boats rigged on Friday morning.

Sunday 4th June

Crews derig boats and load trailers – see itinerary for timings.

Maidstone trailer

Mark Diessner to drive to Lowestoft RC after breakfast and leave car. Paul Gurbutt brings him back to Beccles for the row. Tour finishes at Lowestoft. Trailer returns to Maidstone.

Isle of Ely trailer

Tour finishes at Norwich RC. Trailer returns to Isle of Ely

Goring Gap trailer

Load at Norfolk Broads Yacht Club and park overnight. On Monday JT returns trailer first to Weybridge to unload Weyfarers boats, then to Goring Gap.
